LANTERMAN (ONGOING) REGIONAL CENTER SERVICES:

For persons 3 years and older who have a developmental disability defined as mental retardation, cerebral palsy, epilepsy or autism that originates before 18 years of age and continues or can be expected to continue indefinitely and constitutes a substantial disability. Also included are disabling conditions found to be closely related to mental retardation or to require treatment similar to that required for individuals with mental retardation.
