Dear Families and Those Served by GGRC:

On June 29, 2011, California lawmakers passed a budget bill that transferred the community resource/information and referral responsibilities of the Prevention Program to the local Family Resource Centers. Effective July 1, 2011, the Regional Center will continue to provide intake and assessment. However, case management/developmental monitoring services will no longer be a part of Regional Center services for any new referrals for the Prevention Program.

The infants/toddlers receiving developmental monitoring and case management (through the Regional Center) currently or referred prior to June 30, 2011 will continue to be served per their Prevention Program Plan (PPP).

**Your child is currently enrolled in the Prevention Program and receives developmental monitoring and case management. In the next year, you and your Prevention Team will develop a transition plan that fits the needs of your infant/toddler and family.**

As always, decisions about the services and supports received by a person are determined on an individual basis using Prevention Program Planning (PPP) process. Below are the local Family Resource Centers if you would like to access resources through their organizations.
