Purpose of the System

“The purpose of the statutory scheme is two-fold: to prevent or minimize the institutionalization of developmentally disabled persons and their dislocation from family and community (§§4501, 4509, 4685), and to enable them to approximate the pattern of everyday living of non disabled persons of the same age and to lead more independent and productive lives in the community (§§ 4501, 4750-4751).

i.e.,

1. Prevent or minimize institutionalization
2. Prevent or minimize dislocation from family and community
3. Enable people to approximate the pattern of everyday living of non disabled persons of the same age
4. Enable people to live a more independent and productive life

Achieving the Purposes with Person-Centered Services

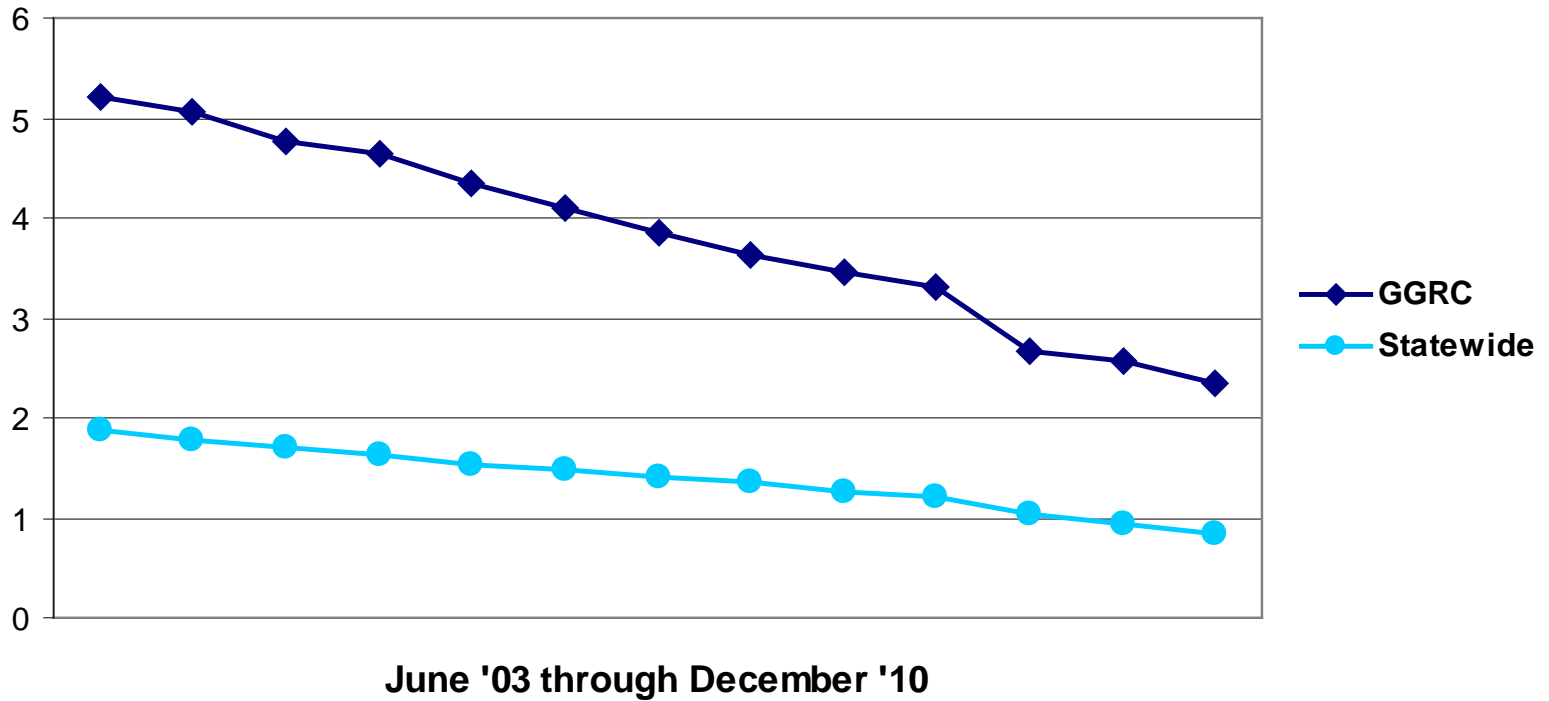
1. **Partnership** with individuals served and families (important for and important to)

 - Services to Adults

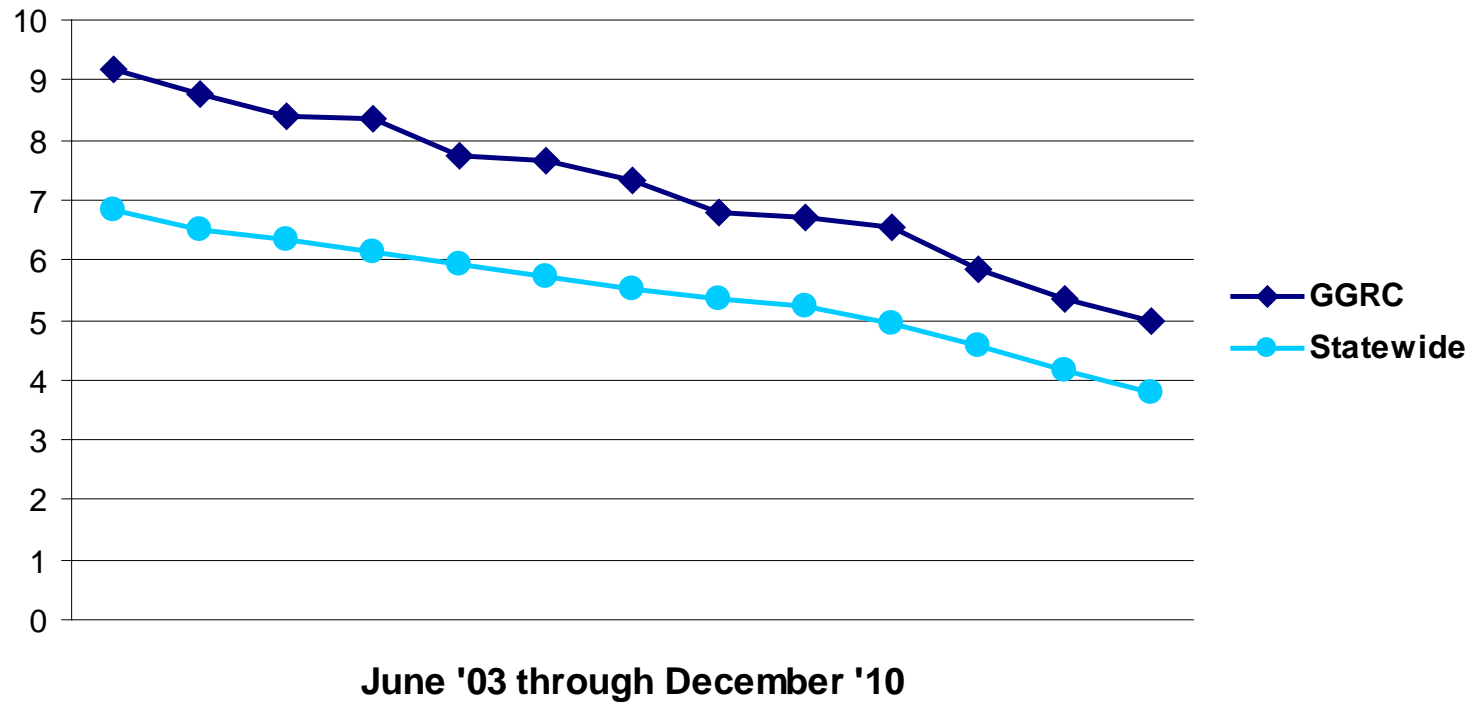
Deinstitutionalization

% Adults Living in Developmental Centers



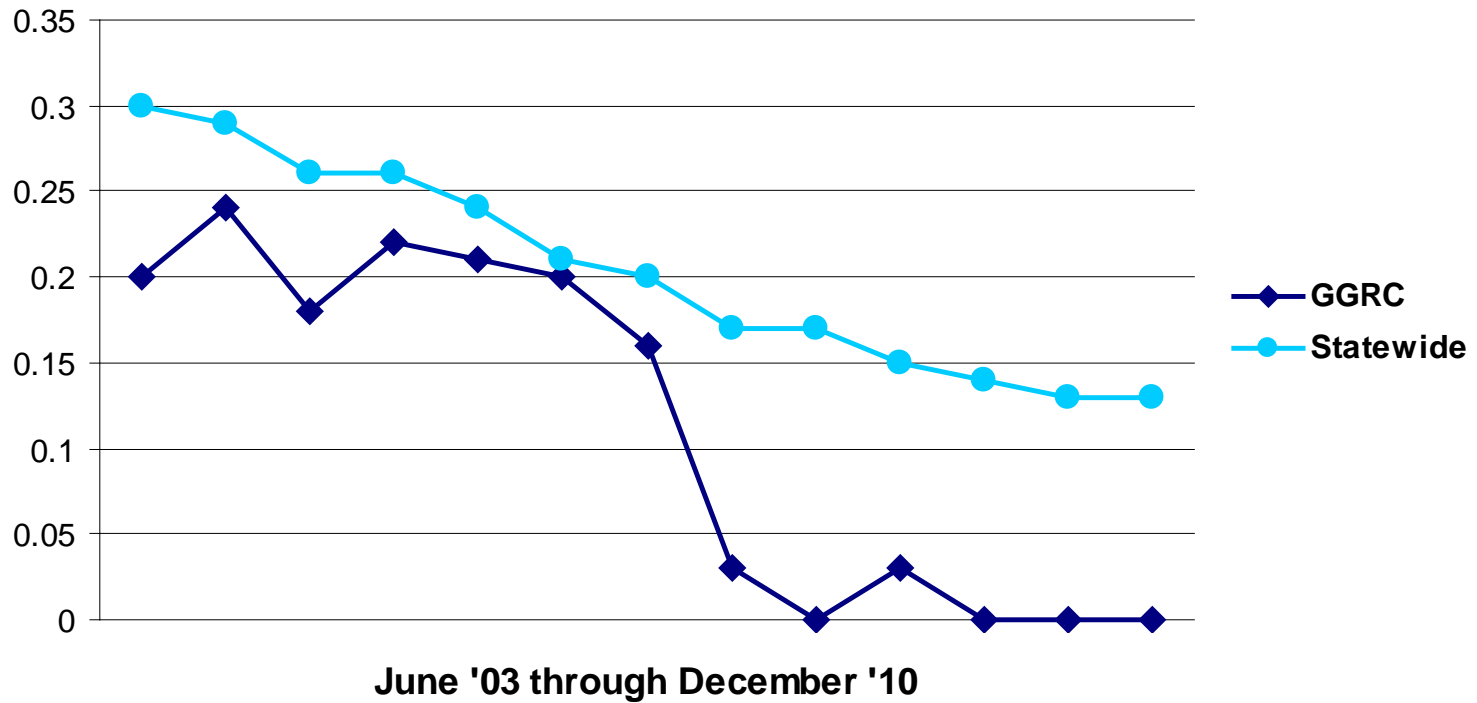
Deinstitutionalization

% Adults Living in 7+ Bed Facilities



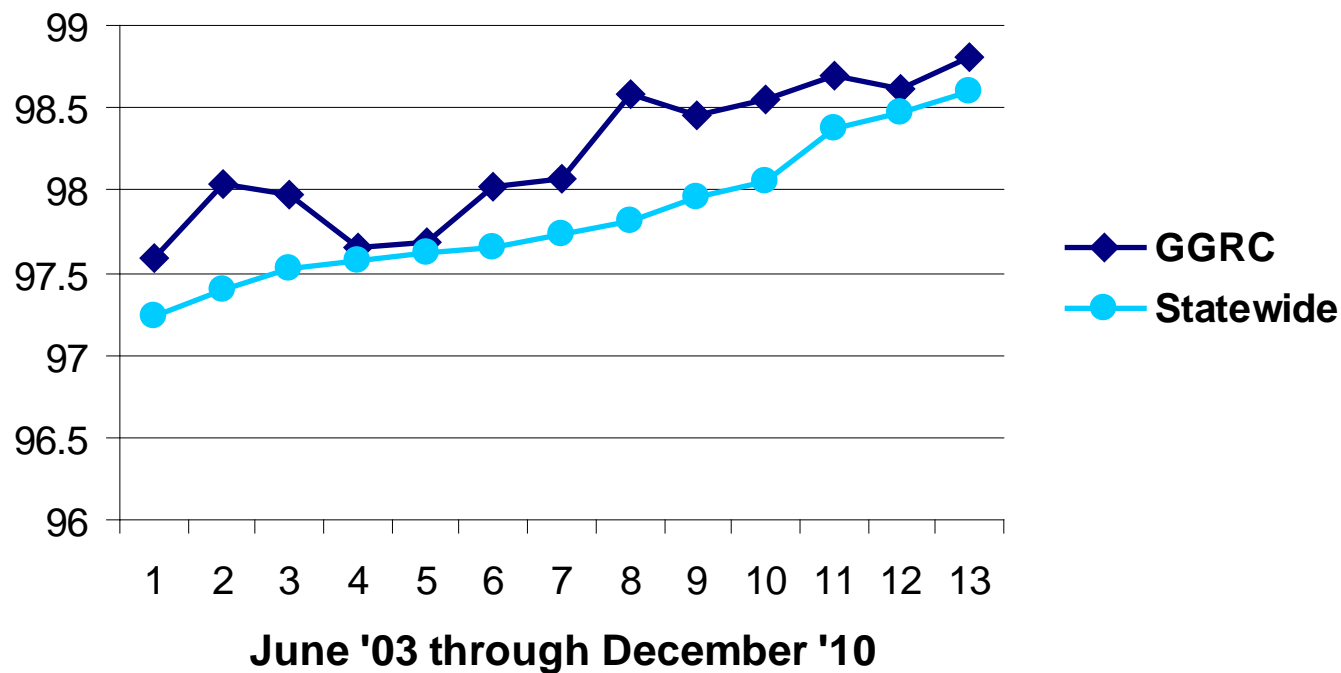
Deinstitutionalization

% Children Living in 7+ Bed Facilities



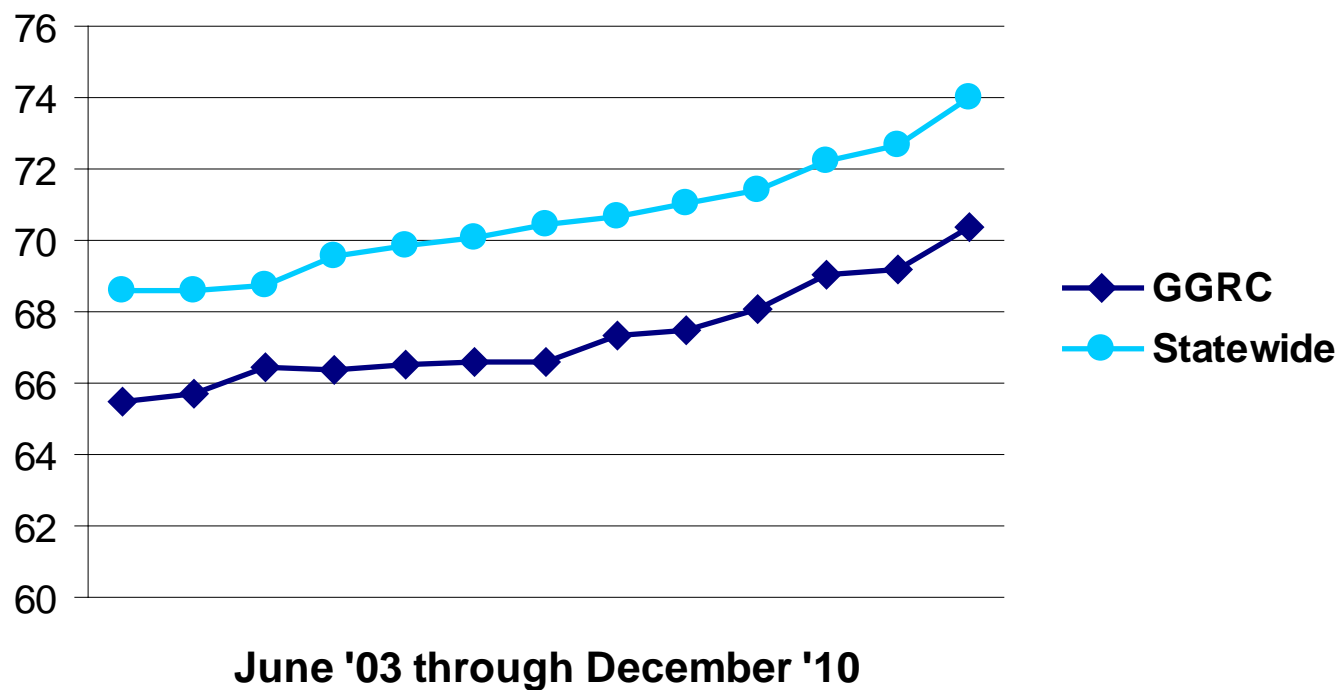
Community Inclusion
