

GGRC's New Service Development Priorities for 2020-2021

Regional Centers have the opportunity to submit a Community Resource Development Plan (CRDP) proposal to California's Department of Developmental Services (DDS) in order to request start-up funding for new service development. Start-up funding awarded to regional centers is determined by DDS. Information guiding the development of this plan was provided by GGRC's stakeholders (individuals receiving services, families, service providers, community partners, etc.) and GGRC staff. Any approved new services and associated start-up funding will be posted on GGRC's website and distributed in accordance with GGRC's Request for Proposal Policy.

GGRC's request for start-up funding in the CRDP proposal will focus on the follow 2020-2021 priorities:

- START (Systemic, Therapeutic, Assessment, Resources, and Training) Services Model (Development & Implementation)
- START Model - Service Provider
- Healthcare Education, Coordination Support & Advocacy including focus on supporting and understanding the access of medical care through tele-services (to be access by Marin, San Francisco, and San Mateo Counties)
- Enhanced Behavior Support (EBSH) Home with forensic support (Marin, San Francisco, or San Mateo Counties)
- Specialized Residential Facility – Behavioral Support Home for Children (Marin, San Francisco, or San Mateo Counties)
- Specialized Residential Facility – RCFE -Behavioral Support Home with 290 Registrant and Forensic Support (Marin, San Francisco, or San Mateo Counties)
- Multi-family Housing/Affordable Housing Development (Marin, San Francisco, or San Mateo Counties)

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
