

GGRC's New Service Development Priorities for 2022-2023

Regional Centers have the opportunity to submit a Community Resource Development Plan (CRDP) proposal to California's Department of Developmental Services (DDS) in order to request start-up funding for new service development. Start-up funding awarded to regional centers is determined by DDS. Information guiding the development of this plan was provided by GGRC's stakeholders (individuals receiving services, families, service providers, community partners, etc.) and GGRC staff. Any approved new services and associated start-up funding will be posted on GGRC's website and distributed in accordance with GGRC's Request for Proposal Process.

GGRC's request for start-up funding in the CRDP proposal will focus on the follow 2022-2023 priorities:

- Children's Specialized Residential Services with Behavioral Support – (Service Provider and HDO renovation funds, San Mateo County)
- Baden Station (Multifamily Housing, South San Francisco, Housing Choices)
- Behavioral Day Program – onsite and community based (San Mateo County, Preference for Multi-lingual and/or Employment Focused)
- Behavioral Day Program – onsite and community based (Marin County, Preference for Multi-lingual and/or Employment Focused)
- Social Recreation Program (Marin County)
- Social Recreation Program (San Francisco County)
- Social Recreation Program (San Mateo County)
